

COVID-19 GUIDELINES FOR PASSENGERS IN OUR HISTORICAL TRAMS

In connection with the Coronavirus, we have taken additional measures to provide you a safe and enjoyable ride.

What measures do we take:

- 1. We have limited the maximum number of passengers in all trams to the number of available seats.
- 2. We clean our trams even more often: bars and seats are cleaned with disinfectant before and after each ride.
- 3. The tram driver is seated at some distance from your group for safety reasons. As a result, there is slightly less interaction between you and the tram driver than we would like to offer, but you can of course still count on an excellent service.

What do we ask from you:

- 1. Participants in the group must be free of COVID-19 symptoms for at least 24 hours prior to the ride. If someone feels sick, develops Corona-related symptoms, or tests positive for COVID-19, unfortunately this person cannot participate in the ride.
- 2. You cannot stand on the front or rear balcony of the 20' trams.
- 3. Wearing a face covering during the tram ride is not mandatory.

We are convinced that in this way we can ensure a very pleasant ride together with you!
